Personal Accountability Commitment

The Iowa Defense Counsel Association (IDCA) first priority is the healthy safety of the attendees registered for the IDCA Annual Meeting & Seminar (the “Event”). In turn, IDCA asks that each attendee takes personal responsibility to do your part and minimize the potential of the spread of communicable diseases at the Event.

Please confirm your acceptance of the **Personal Accountability Commitment**. This is a mandatory requirement and must be done prior to commencement of the Annual Meeting & Seminar. Anyone failing to do so will not be permitted to attend or participate.

By registering for and attending the “Event”, I agree to:

1. Stay home if I develop a fever or have had exposure to any contagious illness, including COVID-19, within two weeks of traveling for the Event.
2. Stay in my hotel room and notify IDCA Staff if I develop a fever or learn that I have been in contact with someone who is diagnosed with any contagious illness, including COVID-19, within two weeks before traveling to the IDCA Annual Meeting & Seminar.
3. Abide by and engage in health and safety measures as defined by the Center for Disease Control (CDC) guidelines.
4. Contact IDCA staff if I develop a fever and/or other symptoms related to a communicable disease including COVID-19 within fourteen (14) days of attending the Event.
